THINGS YOU MAY NOT KNOW ABOUT YOUR HOME IN 3 CHERRY WAY

- Your gutter system on your home has downspouts leading down to the mulched area in the common area around your home. There are 4 of them. One drains onto the driveway, there are usually two in front of your residence and one on the side. There should be a green "popup" at the edge of the mulched area for each downspout. The downspout and the popup work hand-in-hand to get the water off of your roof and away from the foundation. People have discovered that some of these popups have been grown over by grass. If you find that you don't have enough popups, please try to find the missing one. You can do this by using a tool such as a shovel and tap the ground at the edge of the mulched area in alignment with the downspout. The popup will make a hollow sound when tapped. If you are able, dig it out and clean it out so that the downspout will work correctly. If you are unable to do so, please let one of the Board members know and they will get someone to help you.
- 2. The turn off valve for the water to your home is located in the panel on the wall on the right side of your walk-in closet of the master bedroom.
- 3. The lines for connecting cable, Wi-Fi and security service are located in the panel in the coat closet outside the master bedroom.
- 4. The water heater is located in the attic. It is a tankless water heater.
