•	1 tsp of cinnamon	Place in 12"x10"x2" pan. Pour butter mixture over rolls. Then
•	4-6 peaches peeled and quartered	pour the Mountain Dew over pan.
•	1 12 oz Mountain Dew	Bake at 350 for 45 minutes.
